

Instructions for visitors

Osmussaar is home to its residents (people, plants and animals), therefore visitors should not disturb their domestic peace.

Sustainable way of life should be conducted on Osmussaar and the opposite must be avoided.

Camping and fire making is allowed only in prepared spots marked on the map.

Visitors themselves must take all **wastes** produced on the island back to the mainland. There is a waste bin for that purpose in the Dirham port.

Dogs may not be brought along to Osmussaar. If this is done, however, the dog must be held on a leash all the time. The owner covers all material damage caused by the dog.

Contaminating **wells** in whichever manner is not allowed. Water can only be taken with clean containers; all washing is to be done at least 50 m from the well. Well is not to be used for cooling food or drinks.

Disturbing birds, wild animals and **cattle** is prohibited (including chasing and catching them). All gates must be closed again after walking through a yard. There may be electric fences in some yards.

Visitors are not allowed to saw or cut down **trees** or **bushes**. Firewood can be collected from the beach.

Damaging the **clint** and **neugrund-breccias** in any way is not allowed (including removing fossils or other pieces).

Protected **plants** (including orchids) must not be picked, stepped on or harmed in any other way.

Visitors of the landscape reserve can pick **berries** and **mushrooms** and **go fishing** with a hand rod. Fishing with a spinning or a net requires an official permit.
